1. APPLY

Ensure that you apply before the deadline of 1 June 2023. Sign up through the EIT Health application portal, create a log-in and submit your application.

2. GET SELECTED

Your application will be evaluated. It's important that you meet the entry criteria and are proposing an approach to address SDG 3.4 and SDG 3.8 healthcare needs.

3. LEARN

If selected, you will participate in live sessions and form teams on our e-learning platform. Those who complete over 80% of the e-learning activities will be invited to attend onsite training in Austria.

3. PITCH

The onsite activity will entail intensive group work, with the dedicated involvement of coaches. At the end of the week, all the teams will present their exciting new solutions.
